Warehouse Expansion

MS International, Edison NJ

2014 and 2015 kept Charles Mann General Contracting busy renovating and expanding MS International in Edison, New Jersey. MS International was founded in 1975 and imports natural stone from over 35 countries. They currently occupy a 300,000 square foot warehouse and distribution center. In addition, work included cutting openings in existing tilt-up wall panels to accommodate larger overhead doors and dock entrance. The construction also included slab removal and excavation with concrete work to allow for interior loading of delivery trucks. Overhead bridge cranes were also installed for loading granite slabs.
